

Referrer Information Sheet

Who's eligible?

- Aged over 18
- Prescribed tirzepatide (Mounjaro®)
- BMI of at least 40 (reduced to 37.5 for people from South Asian, Chinese, other Asian, Middle Eastern, Black African or African-Caribbean ethnic backgrounds)
- Four or more of the following comorbidities:
 - Dyslipidemia
 - Obstructive sleep apnoea
 - Hypertension
 - Type 2 diabetes
 - Cardiovascular disease

What is covered in the Behavioural Support for Obesity Prescribing programme?

This programme provides structured, support alongside tirzepatide treatment.

Key areas include:

- Integrating medication with behavioural change, to support long-term weight management.
- Nutritional guidance focused on appetite regulation, balanced eating, and sustainable meal planning.
- Physical activity support, including resistance training and movement adaptations for those with limited mobility.
- Sleep and stress management to address common barriers to weight loss and overall wellbeing.
- Goal setting that includes both weight-related and non-scale outcomes for a holistic view of progress.

Skills developed

Throughout the programme, patients will build practical skills to support long-term lifestyle change, including:

- Making enjoyable, sustainable changes to their diet without restrictive eating.
- Developing healthy habits that are realistic and maintainable.
- Managing stress to reduce its physiological impact on health.
- Improving sleep quality to support energy, mood and weight management.
- Finding and maintaining physical activity that suits their preferences and physical abilities.
- Building confidence and autonomy in managing their health beyond the programme.
